General Information

- Flights: \$1,600 or less depending on of year you travel, order flights to Santiago, Chile, through American Airlines or your local travel agent. (American Airlines does not charge baggage fees on International Flights)
- Chile Entry Fee: One time entry fee of \$131 will be charged for the life of a person's current passport.
- Hotels in the Santiago area run around \$55 to \$65 per night. Bernardino will assist you with finding lodging close to your work site. Bro. Bernardino will help you with these types of trip logistics.
- Your food will be on your own or provide by church families. It would be good to assist the church with the cost of preparing the meals, especially if your group is large. Bro. Bernardino will help you with these types of trip logistics.
