### Current Area of Ministry: Pastor of Missions / Evangelism / Outreach

As Pastor of Missions, Pastor Wheaton is responsible for managing our Mission ministry which encompasses Foreign and Home Missions. He manages and supports our foreign missionaries and their ministries in Zambia, Haiti, China, Pakistan, and Mexico. He also manages and supports our Home missionaries which include one Youth Mission and seven church plants. In addition, he assists in the assignment, management and supervision of our homegrown North American Missionaries.

As Pastor of Evangelism, Pastor Wheaton is responsible for engaging the Congregation and ministries in evangelistic efforts through training, incentives, consultation on outreach efforts. These efforts are part of an overarching ministry called "Operation All Things" (OAT) 1 Corinthians 9:22. Rev. Wheaton is responsible for initiating the "Each One Reach One" evangelistic efforts that encourage each member of the Mount to share the Gospel with at least one unbeliever. In addition, he is responsible for encouraging every ministry to make evangelism a part of their weekly focus.

As Pastor of Outreach, Pastor Wheaton is responsible for providing leadership for our ministry to the Garland, Rowlett and surrounding communities. He manages the Mount Hebron Benevolence Ministry which has donated over approximately \$7500 in benevolence assistance.

Pastor Wheaton also accomplishes evangelistic outreach by supporting and assisting ministry teams in two nursing homes in the Garland Community (Pleasant Valley, and Silver Leaf) and One Senior Center in the Garland area (The Carver Senior Center). Other Outreach ministries include a Community Back to School Drive, Angel Tree Projects, and a Katrina Relief Fund. Pastor Wheaton was responsible for assisting in the rejuvenation of monthly door to door Outreach and creating a Welcome to the Community Evangelistic Outreach. The church is currently involved approximately 20 Missions projects.

Other Areas of Responsibility includes Sunday Morning and Wednesday Night Worship Facilitator, Counseling, Preaching, Teaching and staff support.
